- Employ diverse instructional methods, activities, technology, and engaging materials to motivate students and enhance learning outcomes.
- Stay current with evolving instructional methodologies, evidence-based practices, and educational technology to improve teaching effectiveness.
- Establish and maintain effective classroom management strategies that promote a positive, inclusive learning environment.
- Foster open communication with parents and guardians, providing timely updates and information about student progress and needs.
- Regularly assess and monitor student performance and progress to ensure mastery of targeted skills and goals.
- Observe and guide students' social interactions, promoting cooperation, sharing, and positive peer relationships.
