

# BFPS Suggested MS & HS Supply List

## Middle School (6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade):

### Language Arts – 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Grade:

- One 2-pocket folder (plastic is suggested for durability)
- One 3-subject notebook (or one 1-subject notebook for each trimester)
- Writing utensils (pencils/eraser and pens – readable colors please)
- Highlighters

### Language Arts – 8<sup>th</sup> Grade:

- Pens/Pencils
- One composition notebook
- Optional: Markers

### Math:

#### **Must haves:**

- Writing utensils (pencil or pen – NOT neon)
- Binder or folder to organize note sheets and handouts (your preference)

#### **Nice to haves:**

- Lined paper
- Composition notebook for homework if you don't like to write in your workbook

**\*NOTE REGARDING CALCULATORS** – Special graphing calculators are **NOT** needed for 6<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> grade, but if desired Mrs. Ritter would suggest a TI 84 Plus or TI 84 Plus CE (this one is rechargeable).

### Social Studies:

- Notebook
- One 2-pocket folder
- One 3-ring binder (at least 1 ½" please – **7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade**)
- Pencils

### Science:

- One 3-ring binder (1 ½ - 2" please)
- Loose notebook paper (100 sheets)
- Highlighter
- Pack of index/note cards
- One composition notebook



# High School (9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> Grade):

## 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Math (Geometry):

### **Must haves:**

- Writing utensils (pencil or pen – NOT neon)
- Binder or folder to organize note sheets and handouts – (your preference)

### **Nice to haves:**

- Lined paper
- Composition notebook for homework if you don't like to write in your workbook
- Geometry compass (a drafting type compass is best, for example, Mr. Pen, Professional Compass with Lock)

**\*NOTE REGARDING CALCULATORS** – Special graphing calculators are **NOT** needed for 6<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> grade, but if desired Mrs. Ritter would suggest a TI 84 Plus or TI 84 Plus CE (this one is rechargeable).

## 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Math (Algebra):

- Pencils/Pens (Black or Blue)
- Paper/Notebook
- Geometry Kit (protractor, compass, 6-inch ruler, triangles)
- Calculator, TI-30 or equivalent
- Notebook or Binder for Work Folder (graded assignment)

**\*NOTE REGARDING CALCULATORS** – TI 84 Plus or TI 84 Plus CE (this one is rechargeable) are **NOT** required. Mr. Beyer has graphing calculators available for classroom use. Students may also use Desmos/computers/apps for homework.

## Senior Math:

- Scientific Calculator
